EDUCATION OF STUDENTS OF HIGH POTENTIAL

Students of high potential are those students who demonstrate outstanding performance or the assessed potential for such performance or whose abilities, talents and potential for accomplishment in one or more areas of endeavor are so outstanding that they require special provisions to meet their educational needs.

A program for these students shall be identified and provided for students in grades kindergarten through twelve who are intellectually and creatively gifted.

The program shall be flexible, responsive to individual student needs, and provide a variety of options for students of high potential. The options should include higher level learning activities and experiences, opportunity for independent study, access to multiple resources and intellectual peer interaction.

The program shall provide students, families, and educators an atmosphere of support and guidance.
